Honeybees have hair on their eyes.



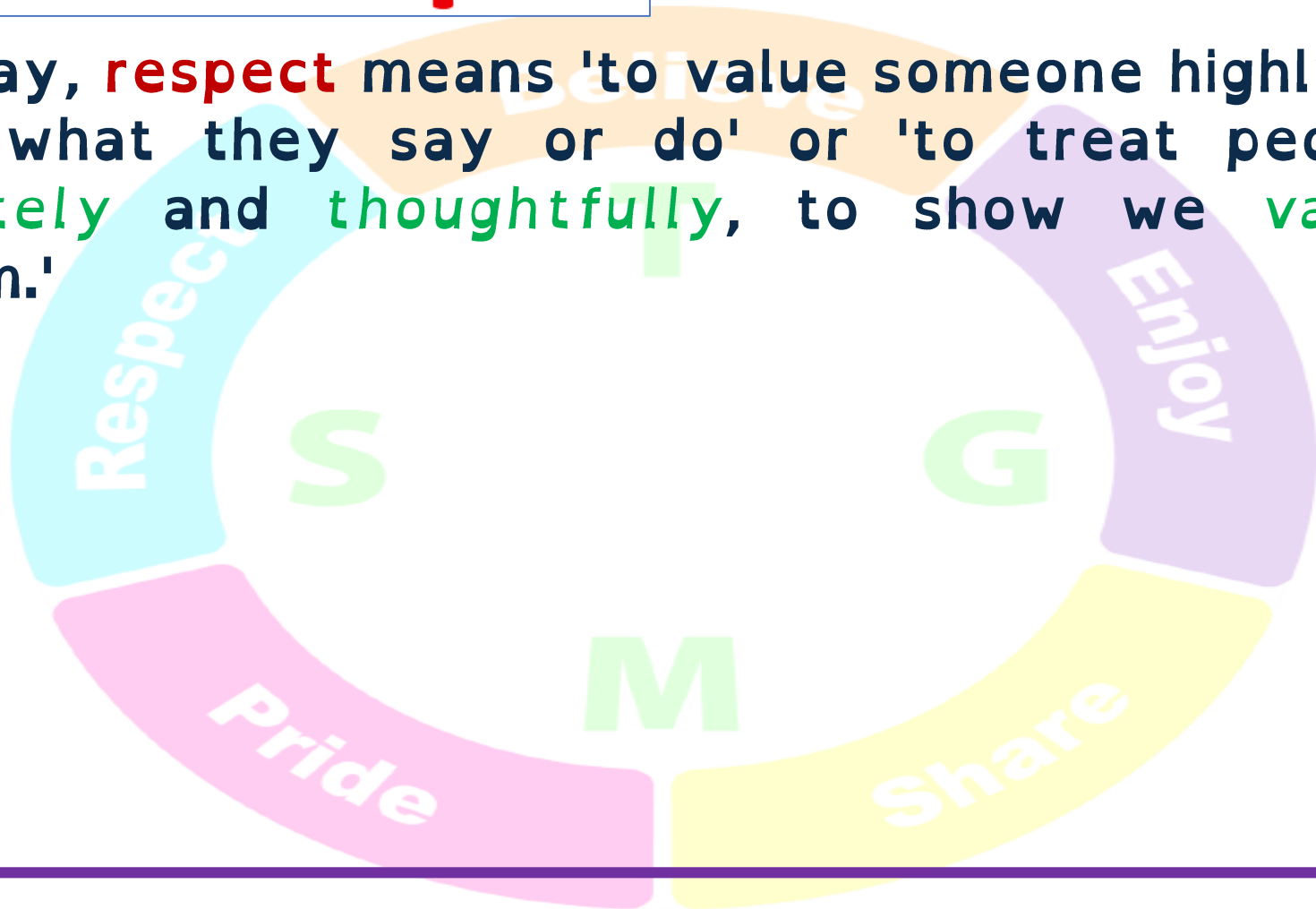
