Dear Year 3 Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your patience and support as we've settled into the new school year. In school, we are thrilled with our well the classes have settled, and we're grateful for the collaborative spirit you've shown in helping us ensure the best experience for your children. I'm pleased to share the following clarifications and updates based on questions that have come through recently:

- **Maths Homework:** This will begin on Monday, 13th October, set on a Monday and due on a Thursday. MyMaths club is available for all and is at 1.15 pm every Thursday. Pupils must ensure they eat their lunch before attending.
- **Autumn Arts Competition:** Although the competition officially closes on Friday, 10th October, Year 3 pupils are welcome to use this coming weekend to prepare and submit an entry if they wish. - **Google Classroom:** Year 3 will begin using Google Classroom in ICT lessons in the second half of the autumn term, so you'll start to see this used more after half-term.
- **Forest School:** This is currently offered as an enrichment opportunity for pupils we feel would particularly benefit from it. All pupils accessing it so far are well prepared — thank you for your support with this. Our aim remains for all pupils to experience Forest School by the end of Year 4.
- **Stick Insect Club:** If your child would like to take a stick insect home, please collect it from the Stick Insect Club by Tuesday, 21st October.
- **Class Representative:** We're pleased to share that we now have a Class Rep in place for Year 3, which we hope will further support communication between home and school.

This account is to be used only by the pupils, not other family members, and Mrs Johnson is more than happy to provide help to parents who are not familiar with using Google as a provider.
My Maths 1st Level				My Maths will be set w/c 13th Oct. More details to follow. Pupils will be shown this in school first.
My Maths 2nd Level				To log in, you need both steps. The first logs into My Maths, the 2nd into your child's dashboard.

Arbor	Home	Child's green cards, attendance, trips, clubs, etc	NA	This is our data management system, and parents/carers have access to a website portal and an app. Y3 parents/carers will be invited to log in to Arbor when it is ready for you, together with an explanation of what you can see and update on there. An important note is that green cards are not updated in real time; depending on teaching commitments, it may take several days for these to be added on Arbor, but they will not be missed! We appreciate your understanding with this.
