

TGMS Year 3 Key Information

Maths Homework

- **My Maths** is set on a **Monday** and due on a **Thursday**.

(NB: My Maths lunchtime club on a Thursday for pupils to complete with support).

- **TT Rock Stars** 10 minutes per week.

English Homework: Set on a **Thursday** and due in on **Monday**. To be completed either in Homework book or Google Classroom (as directed).

Spellings: Given out on a Friday and to be tested on the following Friday.

Reading:

Books changed regularly, as required.

Yellow Reading Log: Each day make a note of the book title and pages read (either by themselves with or with an adult). Pupils should bring it in on a Friday. All pupils who have read 5 times that week and have had it signed by an adult will receive a Green Card (includes the weekend).

Accelerated Reader Quiz: Once pupils have read their book, before they change it, they should complete a “quiz” on the book. This is a short multiple choice quiz that checks their comprehension. The link can be found on the TGMS website and clicking the “Reading” tab.



They can quiz at home and at school.

Table Points and Table Mufti

Pupils can earn table points for working together as well as keeping their areas clean and tidy. The table with the most points at the end of each half term will earn mufti on the last day of that term.

Houses:

Pupils will be placed into one of our Houses: Penn, Ashwell, Beacon & Tyler. Siblings and family members will be in the same house. Pupils gain House Points for positive behaviour, being kind, helpful, showing good effort in their work, etc. House points are collected weekly and the house with the most points will win a big house point every week.

Green Cards:

15 = Bronze Badge / 30 = Silver Badge / 45 = Gold Badge / 60 = All Stars Badge / 100= Super Star Century
