What to pack?

- Packed lunch: On the first day, make sure that you have a packed lunch in your bag.
- Several pairs of comfortable trousers (preferably not jeans as they are uncomfortable if they become wet) and no shorts for outdoor activities.
- Warm clothing such as a tracksuit, long and short-sleeved t-shirts and a couple of fleeces / jumpers
- Underwear and socks (multiple pair in case they get wet)
- Pyjamas
- Waterproof coat and trousers (A popular choice is a waterproof all-in-one/ puddle suit) that can be easily taken on and off over warm clothing).
- Warm hat, gloves and scarf
- 2 x towels (please note that Woodrow does not provide towels and do not have washing or drying facilities for drying towels.
- Toiletries e.g toothpaste, toothbrush, flannel, body wash etc (No aerosol products as these can set off the fire alarm)
- Personal medication (To be handed to Mrs Brown at drop off on the 24th Feb- we cannot accept any medication not indicated on the google form.)
- Indoor shoes (e.g., clean trainers or slippers)
- Outdoor shoes or boots - wellies or walking boots are recommended (they will get very muddy and probably wet)
- Trainers with non-marking soles, suitable for the sports hall
- Refillable drinks bottle
- Plastic bin bags / carrier bags for wet / muddy clothing
- 1x Torch and batteries
- Day rucksack (large enough to contain a packed lunch, drinks bottle, and wet weather gear).

Please note that when arriving in the morning, groups will not have access to their main bags until being shown to their rooms around 5pm, so pack what you need for the first day into your smaller day bag.

Optional:

- A cuddly toy
- A book to read, a small travel game, or colouring.

N.B. Children are likely to get wet / muddy depending on the weather, so we ask that they bring plenty of old warm clothes that they wouldn't mind getting dirty.

Strictly no mobile phones, digital cameras, MP3 players, smart watches and other personal electronic equipment.
