RE: OFSTED INSPECTION – 29–30 APRIL 2025: REPORT PUBLISHED

Dear Parents, Carers and Members of our School Community,

I am pleased to share with you the outcome of our recent Ofsted inspection, which took place on 29 and 30 April 2025. This was a full graded inspection under Section 5 of the Education Act, and I am delighted with the outcomes. We were judged to be:

- **Good** in Quality of Education
- **Good** in Behaviour and Attitudes
- **Outstanding** in Personal Development
- **Good** in Leadership and Management

We are proud that our Personal Development provision was recognised as *Outstanding*. The report notes that: *"Pupils' personal development is exceptional. The school provides extremely strong welfare and pastoral support steered by the school's values."* *"Pupils flourish" and benefit from a "rich set of experiences that develop their understanding of the world around them."*

The inspectors recognised our high ambitions and inclusive culture, writing that: *"Pupils enjoy coming to this inclusive school. They benefit from the school's high ambitions and expectations. They want to learn new things and are eager to share their knowledge."* *"The school is a happy place to be. Pupils behave well, are motivated to learn, and have warm, mutually respectful relationships with everyone in the school."*

We were pleased that our support for children with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) was highlighted: *"Adaptations in lessons for pupils with SEND are well linked to their individual needs across the curriculum. As a result, pupils with SEND achieve well."*

The inspectors praised the school's decisive action to improve standards, our strong curriculum, and the way in which staff work collaboratively to make sure that every change benefits pupils. They acknowledged our commitment to staff well-being and highlighted the strength of our reading and mathematics provision.

Naturally, as a school that is always striving to improve, we welcome the one area for further development: in a small number of subjects, we need to ensure we are consistently checking that pupils have securely understood and remembered their learning, so we can close any gaps more quickly. It was affirming that this target was already present in our 3-year School Development Plan, and the inspector's feedback will prove supportive in how we implement improvements.

This report is a true reflection of our collective work and of a school where children are thriving both academically and personally. I would like to extend my heartfelt thanks to:

- **Our pupils**, for their enthusiasm, kindness and growing independence;
- **Our staff**, for their professionalism, passion and daily care for each and every child;
- **Our governors**, for their challenge, insight and support;
- And **our families**, for their ongoing trust and encouragement.

Tylers Green Middle School is a special place to learn and grow—and I am proud that Ofsted recognised that so clearly. We are excited to continue building on this strong foundation and to keep striving for excellence in every part of school life.
