Important September Reminders

We have communicated several updates over recent weeks and throughout the year, but I wanted to bring the key reminders together here before the summer break.

Firstly, as part of our ongoing work through Guiding Digital Childhoods, and as previously shared, TGMS will no longer accept smartphones from pupils to hand into the office from September 2026, except in agreed exceptional circumstances. We have also shared updated guidance regarding basic phones and GPS tracking devices, including the circumstances in which these may be considered and the expectations attached to their use.

Secondly, uniform and footwear. We would like to remind families that from September 2026, new school shirts and blouses should be buttoned shirts or blouses with collars, not polo shirts. We recognise that some families will already own items purchased previously, but any new purchases should reflect the return to traditional white shirts and blouses. Also, we have noticed increased examples of footwear breaching the guidance, particularly with visible logos or canvas tops. Please refer to our [Uniform Policy](#), which is clear and includes example photos to help inform purchases.

Finally, we have updated our school equipment list to reflect that, from September, pupils will need to use a standard, basic pencil case in school. Pencil cases can be easily purchased online, or are available to purchase from the school office for £1 each.

Thank you for your support in helping us maintain clear, consistent and positive routines for all pupils.

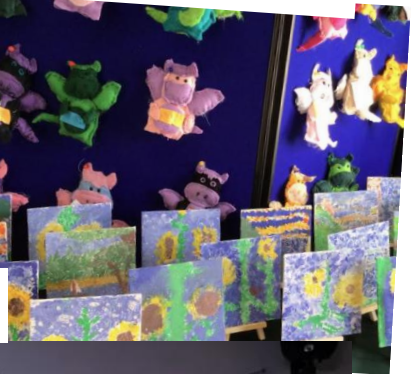
